



Dear Parents/Guardians of South Lane School District Students:

The South Lane School District would like to offer your student access to our electronic communication network. Access to this network will provide your student with Internet and e-mail access.

Part of our responsibility in preparing students for the 21st Century is to provide them access to the tools they will be using as adults. We believe that use of this global information network is one of these tools. The Internet represents a unique opportunity for our students to begin to explore the incredible wealth of information that will enhance their learning. Among other advantages, your child will be able to communicate with other schools, colleges, organizations, databases and individuals around the world.

With this educational opportunity also comes responsibility. It is important that you and your child read the enclosed district policy and administrative regulations and other materials, and discuss them together. When your child is given access to use a computer, it is extremely important that the rules are followed. Inappropriate use will result in the loss of computer privileges and other disciplinary action if necessary.

Please stress to your child the importance of being responsible in the use of his or her account. Your child should never let anyone else use his/her password to access the network. Your child is responsible for any activity that happens in his/her account.

Your student's use of the Internet will be supervised by staff. Please be aware, however, that there is unacceptable and controversial material and communications on the Internet that your child could access despite all our precautions. While SLSD has installed Internet filtering hardware to protect your child from inadvertently downloading inappropriate material, it is not possible for us to always provide direct supervision of all students, nor can we filter material posted on network-connected computers all over the world.

As your student's guardian, you are ultimately responsible for their actions. Please be aware that you are responsible for your student's use of the Internet if accessed outside the school setting. Internet access and its usage will be monitored as best as possible at school, but ultimately it is your student's responsibility to adhere to all guidelines set forth by the district, building, network services, and state and federal law.

Please contact your student's classroom teacher or the school's principal if you have any questions or concerns. If you want your child to have the opportunity to receive an Internet account, e-mail access or google applications, please return the signed consent forms to us as soon as possible.
